ORDER BY name ASC
```

  
 E7 - conditional expression that uses the WHEN and THEN keywords  
 F1 - word added to the negation of IN or EXISTS  
 F5 - name returned by the following query:  

```
SELECT name
FROM people
WHERE name LIKE '%t%'
```

  
 H1 - has rows and columns  
 H8 - the table name follows this clause
